International News

In mid January the cryptospace has been shaken by bitcoin core developer Mike Hearn's farewell letter, where he pointed to the weaknesses of bitcoin, including the block size limit, mining power concentration as well as communication and ethics problems in the bitcoin community. The letter was published on Medium publication platform and soon got retranslated by mass media such as NYT and WSJ. The bitcoin has been dubbed 'dead' once again and BTC price has dropped 16% same day to around \$360.

At the same time we saw Ether-coin sharp increase - in fact almost triple since the end of last year - making Ethereum's blockchain capitalized second next to Bitcoin and exceeding Ripple (see the table). This has coincided with the news release that R3 has successfully prototyped an interaction of 11 banks on Ethereum.

It's quite likely that Hearn's announcement was part of a strategy to turn the media attention to the alternatives for bitcoin blockchain. This event should also push bitcoin community to reach consensus on scaling strategy.

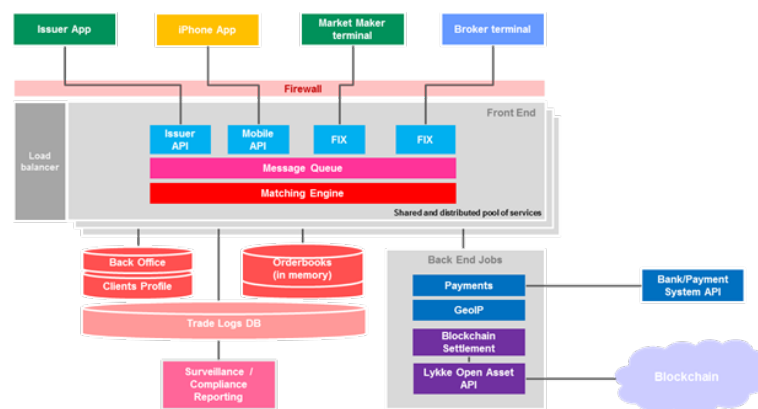

The Lykke Exchange underwent a series of performance tests on Microsoft Azure. Unit tests of various system components (see IT Architecture) allow us to say that the platform can handle over 1 million messages per second with upside to scale to over 8 million. This transaction processing performance is on par with world's best market engines.
